CODE OF CONDUCT IN ARCHEOLOGICAL SITES

- It is forbidden to climb up the pyramids.
- Smoke only in restricted areas.
- Is not allowed to take any vestige with you. What belongs to the site must remain there.
- Do not buy products made of coral, shells, starfish, skin or feather of those animals at risk of extinction.
- Try not to eat in restaurants where meat of animals at risk of extinction is offered.

CODE OF CONDUCT IN NATURAL PLACES.

- Is not allowed to touch, disturb or feed the local fauna.
- It is forbidden to touch or take shells, corals, starfish, etc... what belongs to the sea must remain there.
- It is mandatory to use biodegradable sunscreen lotion in all snorkeling tours.
- Rinse yourself before swimming.
- Do not use flash when taking photos of local fauna
- Smoke Orly in restricted areas.
- Do not buy products made of coral, shells, starfish, skin or feather of those animals at risk of extinction.
- Try not to eat in restaurants where meat of animals at risk of extinction is offered.

CODE OF CONDUCT IN LOCAL COMMUNITIES

- Mantain good behavior.
- Respect traditions and religion of local people.
- Wear appropriate clothing when visiting communities and their localities.
- Do not promote the traffic of archeological pieces
